SNOWMOBILING

Lake Davis has two snowmobile trail staging areas, located from Highway 70 to Portola, turn left on Country Road 126 and follow Lake Davis.

The Lakes Basin Recreation Area south of Graeagle has the Gold Lake Staging Area five miles south of Highway 89 on Gold Lake Highway. Free maps of snowmobiling areas are available at Eastern Plumas Chamber of Commerce office, situated in Blairsden.

Bucks Lake has two staging areas open during the season: Big Creek and Bucks Lake Summit. La Porte has a staging area with a warming hut, restrooms and four trailside warming huts. The Chester-Lake Almanor area boasts five staging areas: Chester-Lake Almanor Snowmobile Park, Swain Mountain, Morgan Summit, and Jonesville.

SNOWMOBILE TOURS Explore! Sierra Touring Company & High Sierra ATV Tours offers two hour tours, which includes helmets, goggles, instructions and safety training. You can also rent boots, gloves, coats and snow pants. Riders meet at the Starbucks in the Chalet View Lodge ten minutes before the tour. Tours are available at 9:00 am and 1:00 pm. GUIDED SNOWSHOE HIKES

Guided snowshoe hikes are led by Rangers, and are held each Saturday and Sunday from early January to early April at the south end of Lassen National Volcanic Park. The hikes are approximately two-hours long and span one to two miles at an elevation of 7,000 feet. Participants will be provided with snowshoes, but must wear boots, dress warmly and be at least 8 years old. Donation is \$1. Call for time, meeting location and reservations at (530) 595-4480.

DOWNHILL SKIING Coppervale Ski Hill is easily accessed a short distance south of Hwy. 36 between Susanville and Westwood. A Poma lift and a rope tow are available to carry skiers and snowboarders up 800 vertical feet. A box ramp is on site with rails of all shapes and sizes. Lessons in Alpine, Cross-Country, Nordic Skiing and snowboarding classes are offered. There is a lodge located at the base of the slope for warming up, stowing your gear, and a snack bar that serves hamburgers and drinks. An adult full day ticket is \$25.00, half-day ticket is \$20.00 (starting at 12:30), and ages 6 and younger are free with a paying adult. (530) 257-9965
